Dissolution Study Committee Meeting

Committee Chairperson Bill Borden opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m.

I wanted to advise everyone that Charlie Zettek has resigned from CGR. Vicki Brown will be handling the Village Dissolution Study from this point on.

I have done a Dissolution FAQ's for the Lyme Light. I think we need to get information out to the public. [See Attached Document] There seems to be quite a few individuals unaware the Village is doing a Dissolution Study.

Chairperson Bill Borden stated that he has been working on a Village District cost worksheet. Take the current services provided by the village at this time and the cost to maintain them. How will that carry over if the Village were to dissolve? Will the cost stay the same or will it increase or decrease? What services will be terminated and which will continue if the Village was to dissolve. Need to look at the impact on the quality of life.

The current Village employee's what will happen to their positions if the Village were to dissolve? Would the Town keep the Village employees? Chairperson Borden asked Supervisor Scott Aubertine if the Town Board would be able to address this question at their next board meeting? Supervisor Aubertine stated that it would have to be addressed at the March meeting due to the Town Board having a full agenda in February.

Committee member Radley stated he felt there is a need to have the Dissolution committee meet with the Town of Lyme Board and try to answers some of these questions. Chairperson Borden stated if Scott Radley wanted to forward his questions to him he will attending the March Town Board meeting and will try to get answers to his questions.

Chairperson Borden stated the Town of Lyme Board is a key component to the Village dissolution plan. Our goal is to open up a discussion with the board and find out what it looks like from the Towns board perspective. There are still a lot of unanswered questions that need to be answered.
