Currently, the engineers and public works directors are already in continuous discussion about capital improvement projects (roads, sewers, equipment, etc.) involving the Borough, Township and PSOC.

Because of the financing of many capital road / sewer projects through the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust Fund, they have already done a lot of coordination on capital projects and this approach has spilled over to other aspects of engineering and public works over the past few years.
