Subject: TTF Website Statistics

FYI, I was just provided with the website statistics from May. From 5/1 to 5/31, the TTF site was viewed 7,083 times, with users downloading documents 2,062 times. The most commonly-downloaded document was the Organizational Charts presentation, 367 times. In terms of basic pageviews, the TTF's website was the most active of all CGR community consolidation / shared service sites, with six times as many views as the next most active site.
